Also have adult partial hospitalization program and adolescent program – refer into those programs by calling CMC. They attend all day and then they go home and spend the evening at home, 15 day programs.

Residential crisis program, finally submitted application and waiting to hear from DHS

Elizabeth Filmore stated their employment services at capacity in Duluth and open to referrals.
