# Lakes and Pines Head Start and Early Head Start

Head Start is a family focused early childhood development and school readiness program for children age birth to five years, including pregnant moms. All Head Start services are provided at no cost. We believe parents know their children best and are their child's first and most important teacher. We work to guide you through your child's healthy development and assist your family with setting and achieving goals.

## Program Options:

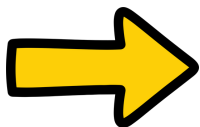
**Center-Based** – Early Head Start serves children ages 16 months to 3 years, and Head Start serves children ages 3 to 5. Programs are available in Mora, Cloquet, and Chisago City.

**Home-Based** – A teacher visits your home weekly to work with you and your child. Services are available for pregnant moms and children up to age 5 in all seven counties.

**Family Child Care** – Learning in a licensed childcare setting, available in Milaca and Princeton.

**Child Care Partnerships**- Child Care Partnerships in Onamia serve children from infancy to age 5. Programs in Aitkin, Barnum, and Pine City serve children ages 16 months to 5 years. All programs operate year-round.

**School Partnerships** - Partner with local schools to serve children ages 3 to 5 in Pine City, North Branch, Cambridge, and Princeton.
